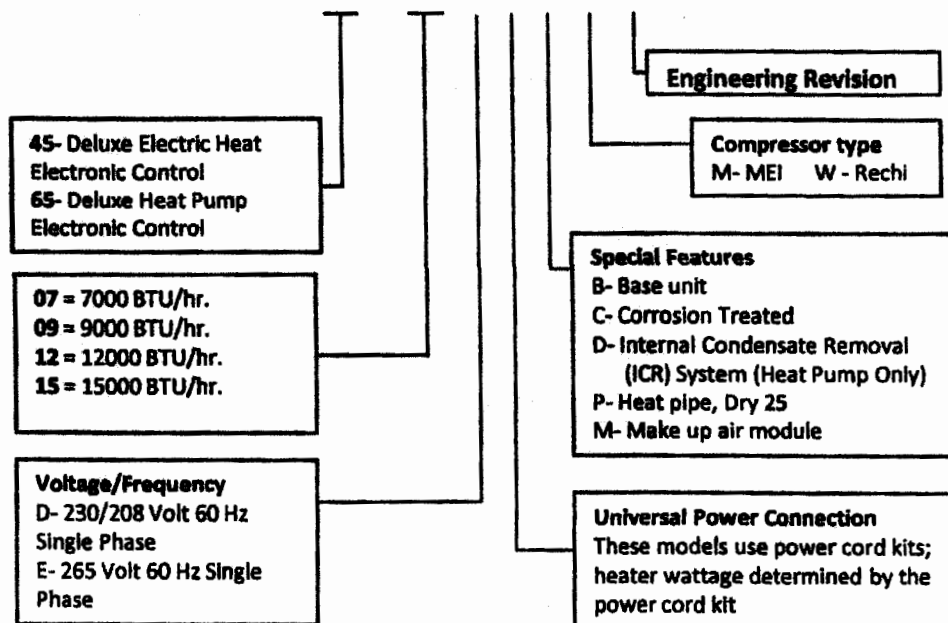

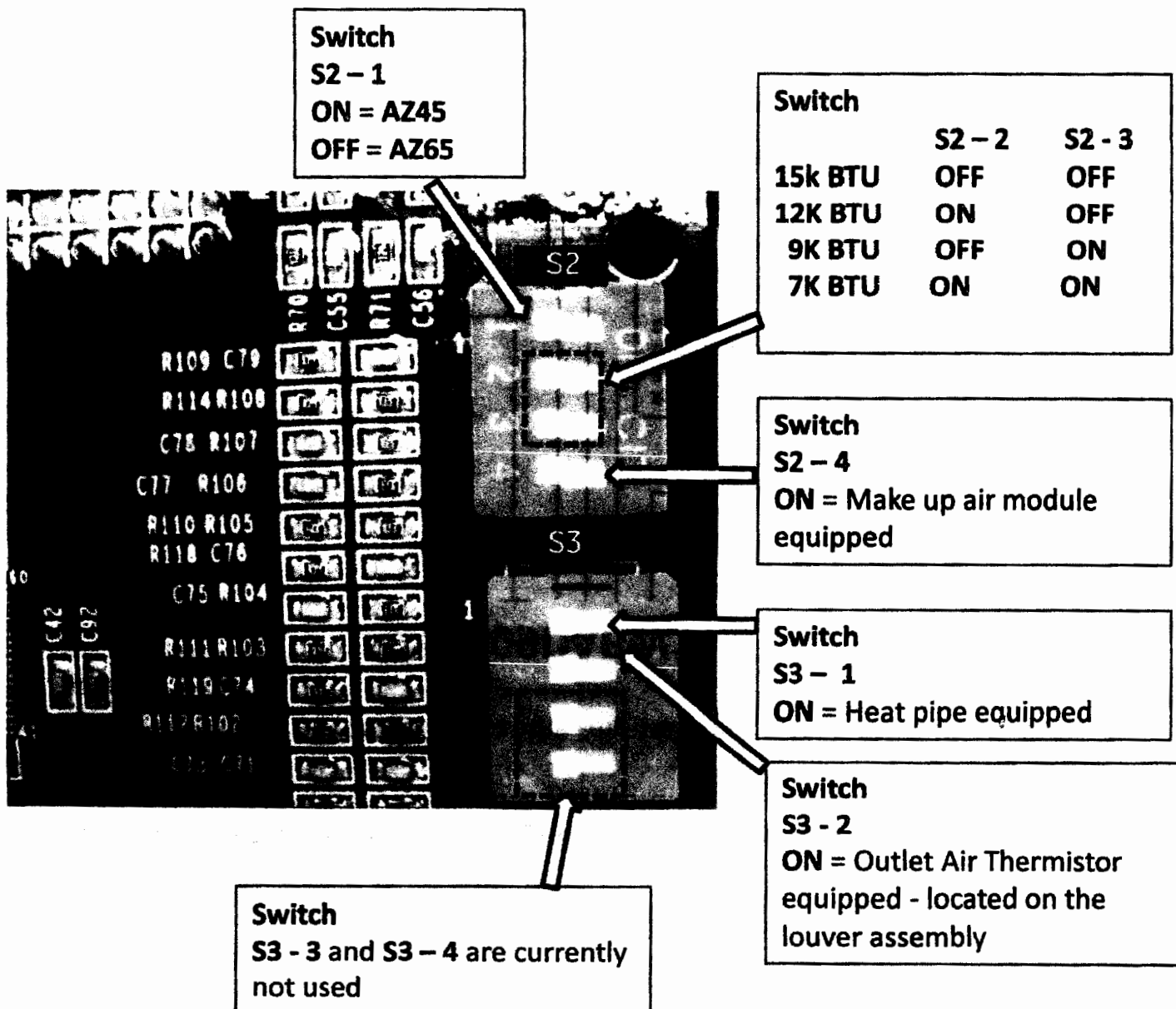

### Replacement of Main Board on AZ45 and AZ65 Zonelines

1. Disconnect power and access main board.
2. Disconnect all connections on the original board.
3. Remove original board and install the new board.
4. Reconnect all connections.
5. Use the chart on the next page to set the "dip-switches" to correspond with the model number.

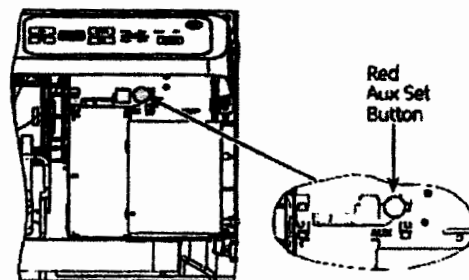
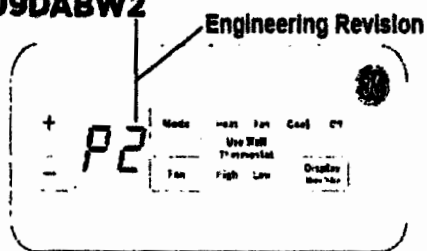


6. Reassemble and re-apply power.

7. When the unit is powered on after replacing the board, the display will show "P1." Press the "+" button until the second digit matches the last number in the model number as shown below.
